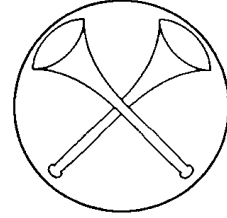

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Minutes of the March 11, 2012 Meeting

Meeting commenced at 11:15 AM.

In attendance were: Cormac *Crescent*, Jeanne Marie *Dolphin*, Mary *Bellows*, John *Seraph*, Damien *Sable Fret*, and Catherine Aimeri de Winter.

Tentative meeting schedule: April 1st, May 13th, June 10th, July 15th, August 12th, Sept. 9th, Oct. 14th, Nov. 11th, and Dec. 2nd (Yule party)

Approved submissions were forwarded to Laurel on the March 11, 2012 Letter of Intent.

Society News:

- At Crown Tourney, Mary *Bellows* was invited to join Order of the Pelican.
- Also at Crown Tourney, Giles *Chrysostom* was created a Herald.

From the January LoAR:

- The Admin Handbook has been changed – it is no longer required that forms be changed to match the LoI. That means if a name or blazon is changed by the CoH, the form doesn't have to be updated.
- Pelican's series "Some Name Resources" deals with the language mixes.

From Crescent:

- The first Quarterly report has been submitted to Laurel. It is positive.
- We received a thank you note from Mistress Robynne for our contribution toward the lawsuit funds.

From Dolphin:

- Comments to the BoD regarding the proposed new rules should be sent to comments@sca.org. The rules are likely to be discussed at the March BoD teleconference. If not, or if the rules are remanded to the April BoD meeting, Laurel, Pelican, Palimpsest, and possibly Wreath will be attending the April BoD meeting. We have discussed with Gabriel *Laurel* the possibility of a get together either Friday evening or Sunday. Details are pending, but it will be open to all interested parties. More details will be available at the April CoH meeting.
- There are several general LoPaD issues open from January. If you wish to comment on any of these and don't have commenting privileges, Crescent or Dolphin will be happy to post on your behalf. The issues:
 - January 7th: Crescents and Things: Discussion on how we should blazon and count conflict against the motif of *within a crescent, a 'charge'*.
 - January 7th: Mullets and Estoiles, Take Two: Discussion on what difference should be granted between mullets/estoiles (and suns) of different number of rays/points.

- January 7th: Norse Capitalization: Revisiting the decision that bynames must be lower case.
- January 7th: Request for Comments on Patterns in Order Names and Heraldic Titles.
- January 31st: Dragano Chavalerio: Discuss what forms of titles should be protected.

March Submissions

Gillian Jewell - Resub Kingdom Name Change & New Device Change. *Purpure, on a lozenge ployé Or a gillyflower gules, slipped and leaved vert*

Old Item: *Per pale purpure and vert, a chalice within a bordure rayonny Or*, to be retained as a badge.

Submitter desires a feminine name and will accept all changes. If the name is registered, the registered name, *Alice de la Paleysse*, should be retained as an alternate. This name was returned at the February 2012 CoH meeting for lack of funds.

Gillian is found in Withycombe, p. 134, as the header spelling. "Middle Ages."

Jewell is found in Reaney and Wilson p. 256, s.n. Joel, dated in this spelling to 1462.

Under the current rules, this device conflicts with *Purpure, on a lozenge ployé Or a bunch of grapes proper* (device, Caterina Nadalini, Ansteorra, 2001). There is a single CD for the changes to the tertiary charges. However, under the new rules (which are expected to be in place by the time this is considered by Wreath), it is clear with a DC under A.5.G.3 for changing the tincture of the tertiary charge and a DC under A.5.G.4 for changing the type of the tertiary charge. We are therefore forwarding this for consideration.

Gillian Jewell - Resub Laurel Badge. *(Fieldless) On a lozenge ployé Or conjoined to four roundels in saltire argent a lozenge gules*

Her previous submission, *(Fieldless) In pale a chalice Or conjoined to a palace argent*, appeared on the January 2012 LoI under the name Alice de la Paleysse. It was withdrawn February 2nd.

We believe that the presence of the roundels, even as maintained charges, mean that this cannot be considered a display of *<i>Gules, a bordure Or</i>*.

Badge is approved and forwarded to Laurel.

Magnus bj{o,}nkarl – Resub Kingdom Badge. *Potenty azure and Or, a phoenix gules rising from flames argent*

His previous submission, *Gyronny sable and gules, a theow rampant argent*, was returned at the January 2011 CoH meeting for lack of contrast and conflict. This is a complete redesign.

Device approved and forwarded to Laurel.

Ponç lo Bonòme – Resub Kingdom Badge. *(Fieldless) A quill pen fesswise distilling a goutte sable*

His previous submission, with the same blazon, was returned at the February 2012 CoH meeting for redraw.

Badge approved and forwarded to Laurel.

Stæina Hálfdanardóttir - Resub Kingdom Name

Submitter desires a feminine name.
Language (unspecified) most important.
Culture (unspecified) most important.

The submitter desires a feminine name and will accept all changes. If the name must be changed she cares most about the (unspecified) language/culture. Her previous submission, Stæina inn Danskidottir, was returned at the October 2011 CoH meeting for lack of documentation of the byname.

Stæina is feminine given name found on Gunvor's Viking Answer Lady site (<http://www.vikinganswerlady.com/ONWomensNames.shtml#Odd>) as being found in Lena Peterson, *Nordiskt runnamnslexikon*

Hálfdan is masculine given name found in Geirr Bassi; the patronymic is found as an example on p. 17.

Name is approved and forwarded to Laurel.

Starkhafn, Barony of – New Badge. *(Fieldless) On a mullet of eight points a flame proper*

Note: The depiction of a flame proper as Or fimbriated gules is grandfathered to the barony.

Also, they would like this badge to be used as their baronial champions' badge.

Badge approved and forwarded to Laurel

Willem de Bathe – New Name and New Device. *Per pale Or and gules, a tower between two crosses coupé counterchanged*

The submitter desires a masculine name and will accept all changes.

Willem is a Dutch masculine given name. "Dutch Names 1358-1361" by Aryanhwych merch Catmael (Sara L. Uckelman) at <http://heraldry.sca.org/names/dutch/earlydutch14.html> cites this spelling as the most common form of the name.

de Bathe is found in Bardsley, p 84, under Bathe, Bathe, dated to the reign of Edward III.

The combination of Dutch and English is a step from period practice.

OP note: Willem has an AOA granted to him by the Kingdom of Ansteorra in 2010. (from the Ansteorra OP -
