On Correcting the Order of Precedence

Caid's Order of Precedence is a living document that has been maintained by several volunteers for several decades. As such, it is by its very nature prone to missing data. Please look at your record, as well as those you know, to make sure that all awards appear in this current edition of the Order of Precedence.

If an award or honor should appear and does not, we will be happy to add it! There are several forms of evidence that we will accept as proof that you are entitled to the award.

- 1. A scroll or promissory, signed by the Crown or Baronage, with your name and the award name
- 2. A photograph of you holding a scroll or promissory as above, even if the original is lost.
- 3. A statement from the Crown or Baronage who gave you the award (email is fine)
- 4. A statement from the presiding officer (herald) of the court where you were given the award (email is fine)
- 5. A statement from the Chamberlain, Chief Lady in Waiting, or Captain of the Guard, who witnessed your receiving this award
- 6. Video footage of the award ceremony where you and the award can be identified
- 7. An audio recording of the award ceremony where your name and the award can be identified
- 8. A copy of a Kingdom Order of Precedence wherein you and the award are identified
- 9. If a Baronial award, a copy of a Baronial Order of Precedence from that Barony wherein you and the award are identified

If you cannot provide the above documentation, but you feel that you have similar evidence that you received the award, please contact Crescent at herald@sca-caid.org to make your case.
